Campsite Rules & Information

General Rules

- All guests must follow the official campsite rules at all times.
- You must pay before pitching your tent or caravan.
- Please stay within your designated camping area.
- All tents and caravans must be pitched in straight lines, with at least one car width of space between each unit.
- Guy ropes must not overlap with those of neighbouring tents.

Vehicle Safety



- There is a strict speed limit of 5mph across the campsite.
- Only fully licensed drivers may drive on site. Learner drivers and unlicensed individuals are not permitted to drive.
- Always drive on the marked roadways – do not drive across sports pitches.

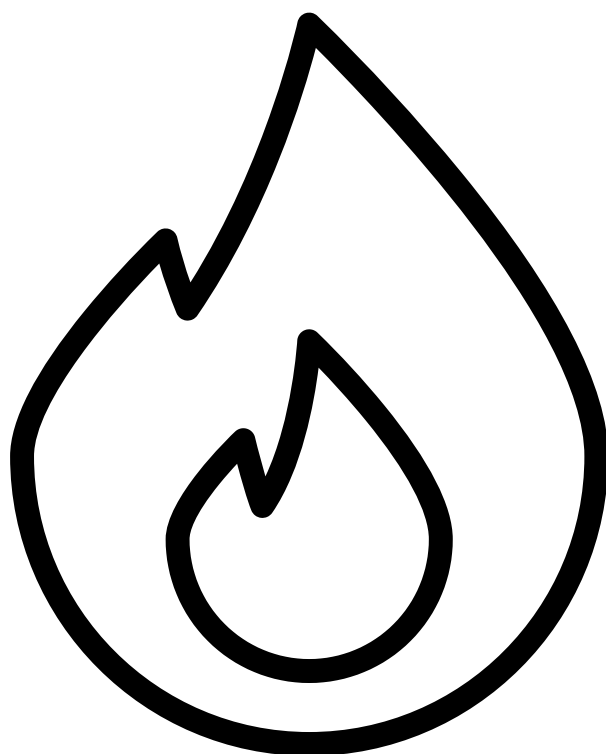
Security & Responsibility

Fire Safety

- Open fires are not permitted.
- Barbecues are allowed but must be raised off the grass and fully extinguished. Dispose of them the following day once completely cold.
- A bucket of water must be placed outside every tent or caravan as a safety precaution.
- Do not tamper with or misuse fire equipment or water hoses.
- The release of Chinese lanterns is strictly prohibited.



Dogs

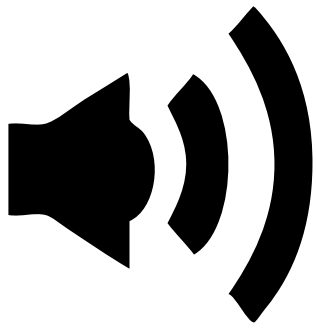
- Dogs are welcome but must be kept on a lead at all times, except in the designated dog exercise area.
- Owners must clean up after their dogs promptly and responsibly.



Smoking & Conduct

- The entire school and campsite is a no-smoking area. Anyone caught smoking may be subject to a fine of up to £2,000 issued by the school.
- Breaching the site rules may result in a formal warning, or in serious cases, removal from the site.
- No refund will be offered in the event of eviction from the campsite.



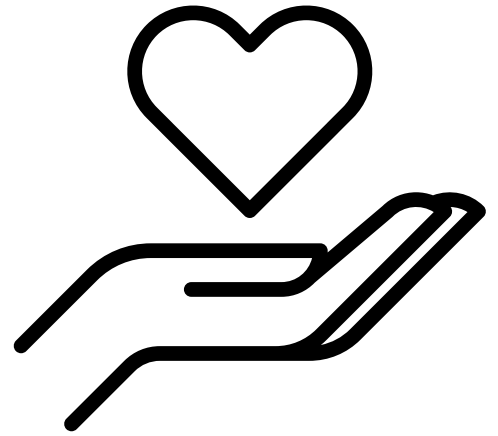


Noise & Generators

- These will be emptied and cleaned on Tuesday and Thursday.
- A skip is provided for general household rubbish – please use it to keep the site clean and tidy.

- Drinking water taps are located near the entrance to the shower area.
- Please use only the designated hose for disposing of wastewater.

Showers

- Opening hours: 7:30am – 8:00pm
- Staff-only access: 6:30am – 7:30am
- Please note that the school changing rooms are communal.



The Wessex Kitchen

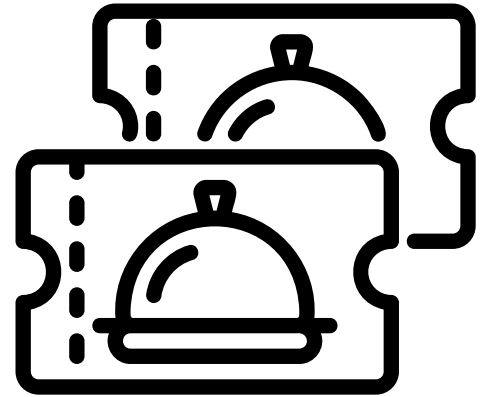


The Wessex Kitchen will be open daily, serving:
